RESOLUTION OF THE ELRC

Resolution 14 of 1996

The parties to the Council -

1. Note the report of the Legal Committee of the Council with regard to the proposed draft Constitution of the ELRC and that the matters raised on 1 November 1996 by SADTU were not resolved.
2. Agree that -
 - 2.1 the finalisation of the draft Constitution of the ELRC is an urgent matter to be resolved within 30 days after the coming into operation of the Labour Relations Act, 1995;
 - 2.2 a consultative meeting(s) between the employee parties to the Bargaining Committee will be arranged to deal with identified amendments to the draft Constitution of the ELRC;
 - 2.3 consultative meetings between the employer parties and the employee parties be arranged to deal with the identified amendments to the draft Constitution of the ELRC;
 - 2.4 a facilitator be appointed from an agreed upon list to facilitate a workshop on, and the process of amending the draft Constitution of the ELRC, and to resolve differences that may arise during the course of the above processes; and
 - 2.5 the Bargaining Committee must finalise the draft amendments to the draft Constitution before 1 December 1996 for adoption by Council on 6 December 1996 and the meeting of 16 October 1996 will be deemed to still stand adjourned for this purpose.
